

PHOTO Elements TECHNIQUES

Customized Picture Stacking

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Use the Picture Stack Guided Edit to create fun images and then go to Expert mode to customize.

Photoshop Elements 14 was used in this video. The technique will work with version 13 as well.

1. Open the image you want to use in **Guided** mode, **File>Open**.
2. Click on the **Fun Edits tab** if you're using PSE14, or **Photo Play** if you're using PSE13, and select **Picture Stack**.
3. Select the **Number of Pictures** you want for your picture stack, set the **Border Width**, select the **Background Color**, and click the **Next button** and then click **Done** (PSE13 click the Done Button).

4. Click the **Expert tab** at the top of your workspace to enter Expert mode.
5. Select the **Move tool** and in the Tool Options bar, make sure that **Auto Select Layer**, **Show Bounding Box**, and **Show Highlight on Rollover** are all checked.
6. Resize, reposition and delete the layers as desired.
7. Feel free to add text.
